LUTHERAN WITNESS Did you know that the LCMS publishes a wonderful magazine called the Lutheran Witness? It is published 11 times a year (monthly, with a combined June/July issue) and is full of useful articles for members of LCMS congregations with topics ranging from apologetics to archaeology to tough questions on today's sexuality. It is a doctrinally sound, layman-accessible resource designed to help Lutherans to engage our challenging culture in an informed, intelligent manner, while standing firm for Truth. Additionally, the center insert contains news from our own Mid-South district. A limited number of free copies of back issues of The Lutheran Witness are available in the giving center. Pick one up and give it a read. The annual subscription price is \$28.25. However, the Mid-South District is funding \$13.25 for each subscription to the Lutheran Witness with hope that all households will receive this valuable resource.
